Questions Asked by *Praxis*™ Candidates

- 1 How do I know which test to take?**
Each state that uses Praxis tests sets its own testing requirements. To find out which test you should take, check your state's requirements page at www.ets.org/praxis/states.
- 2 How do I locate a test center/test date/deadline?**
Test centers, dates and registration deadlines can be found at www.ets.org/praxis/centers.
- 3 How do I register for a *Praxis* test? Are both the *Praxis I*® and *Praxis II*® tests available online?**
*You can register at www.ets.org/praxis/register. The *Praxis I* test is available in a computer-based format; however, the *Praxis II* tests are given in a paper-based format only.*
- 4 Why do I have to pay the registration fee again?**
Registration fees are assessed once per "test year," which is different from a calendar year. A test year runs from September to July.
- 5 How do I add a test to my registration or change my test date, center or test type?**
