**For teacher candidates pursuing Cross Categorical Special Education teaching certification the following additional courses and credits are required:**

**For teacher candidates pursuing Early Childhood Certification added to their ESL and/or Bilingual license the following courses and credits are required:**

Foundations of Early Childhood Education (5 Credits)

All courses are graduate level credits approved by Silver Lake College and apply as electives in their Masters in Teacher Leadership Program.

## Application Requirements

In order to be considered for the Teacher Development Center Program, you **must** :

1. be hired by a school district in a high need area with an emergency license or permit
2. show evidence of passing the Praxis I (more information regarding the Praxis test requirements is on our website [www.cesa7.k12.wi.us](http://www.cesa7.k12.wi.us))
3. submit a completed application form with a non-refundable \$50.00 application fee payable to CESA 7 with all of the following documents::

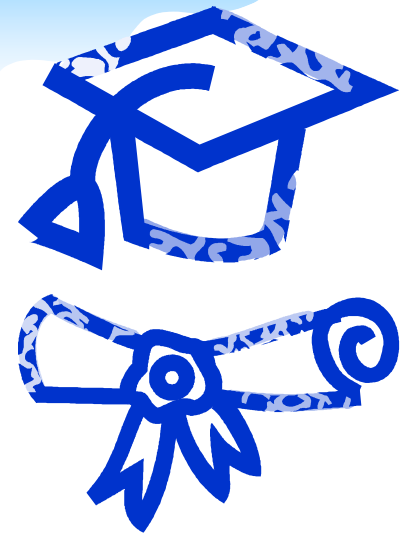


- A resume and three letters of reference.
- A copy of an emergency teaching license or permit and copies of any other licenses held.
- Proof of a Bachelor's Degree in such areas as engineering, music, art, foreign language, computer science, math, science, or education from an accredited institution of higher education.
- An official copy of transcripts from degree granting university (sealed or stamped) with at least a 2.75 grade point average overall on a 4.0 scale
- Successful completion of a criminal background/check.
- Record of passing the Praxis I (PPST)\*.
- Validation of school district employment (letter from school district or copy of contract).

After reviewing the application materials, the Program Coordinator will contact each applicant regarding the status of their application.

*\*Certified teachers seeking ELL, Bilingual or special education certification added to their license are exempt from the Praxis I exam,*

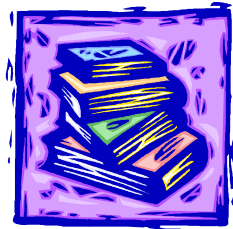

## Want to be teachers and ...

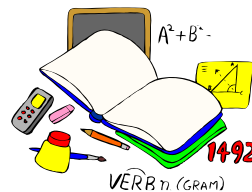
- have a four-year college degree in high needs areas, and

**OR, are teachers and want to add ELL , Bilingual, Early Childhood or Special Ed. certification.**

The not-for-profit CESA 7 Teacher Development Center was created in direct response to school district needs for high quality teachers in specific fields.

## Basic Qualifications for Teacher Development Center Candidates

- Must be hired by a school district under an emergency teaching permit or license.
- Have a Bachelor's Degree in such areas as engineering, music, art, foreign language, computer science, math, or science from an accredited institution of higher education **OR**, have a teaching license and seek to add ELL, Bilingual, Early Childhood or Special Education certification.
- Have experience in a professionally related field in which the degree was awarded. **OR**, have graduated with outstanding grades and school/ community contributions.
- Demonstrate reading, writing and math competence with a passing score on the Praxis I test from Educational Testing Service and subject competence with a passing score on the Praxis II test.



## Teacher Development Center (TDC) Program

Once hired in a teaching position with an emergency license, candidates will earn all the wages and benefits specified in the teaching contract for their school district while simultaneously completing instruction approved by the CESA 7 Teacher Development Center Program.

Once accepted, candidates must also successfully complete the required courses in the Teacher Development Center Program teaching requirements, including an electronic portfolio and a reflection journal (see our website for course descriptions).



Formal instruction will occur prior to, during, and after the school year. Participants will learn, in part, about best instructional practices, assessing student progress, classroom management, and other effective instructional strategies; Additionally, CESA 7 will provide on-the-job coordination and support.
