REGISTERING AN “ALTERNATE TEAM” for Local Competition

In the past, coaches have asked if there is a way to accommodate a “few additional students” that have interest in competing at Local Competition (beyond their first or second team) — without paying another \$350 entry fee for an “incomplete” team.

Per May 16, 2008 Board approval, the opportunity for additional students to take the Local tests is now available. Qualifying schools must have registered at least one complete team and paid the corresponding \$350 entry fee.

Additional alternates (1-5 students), short of a full nine-member team, are allowed to take the Local tests – with their registered team – for a “set fee.”

The alternate team fee is \$100 for 1 – 2 students or \$150 for 3 – 5 students.

Note: Alternate team members will NOT be eligible to receive award ribbons.

Policy/Procedure:

In order for a coach to register an “alternate” team:

1. Coach has registered one (or more) complete team(s) for the season.
2. **All alternate teams must be registered by October 7, 2011.**
3. Coach is required to sign an alternate team roster certifying that students are in the correct GPA category in accordance with WIAD guidelines.
4. Alternate team members are required to sign a Competition Conduct form prior to testing — same as official team members.
5. An Official Student Transcript will be obtained for each alternate team member and submitted to the Test Director along with the Official Team’s transcripts and Competition Conduct Form on Local Competition testing day.
6. **“Alternate” team members will not be eligible for award ribbons.**
7. Coach will receive a hard copy of the alternate team’s testing scores, but alternate team scores on any scoring reports will be listed as “0”.
