

# WISCONSIN ACADEMIC DECATHLON

## Local Competition Schedule

**DATE:** **Tuesday, November 8, 2011**

**TIME:** **9:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon** (Time may vary slightly by test site.)

**PLACE:** **19 designated sites throughout Wisconsin.** Schools are assigned to a test site through the local CESA **Test Coordinator. Do not contact the Test Director!**

**EVENTS:** 1. **SIX WRITTEN TESTS** — Art, Economics, Language & Literature, Mathematics, Music (includes audio CD), and Science.

There are 50 questions for each of the timed tests except Math with 35 questions. **Each test is scheduled for 20 minutes, except Math at 30 minutes.** Each correct question is worth 20 points (except Math = 28.57) for a maximum total of 1000 points per test or 6000 maximum points per student.

2. Generally, the test day will begin at 9:00 a.m. and finish approximately three hours later. Your starting time will be identified by your CESA — times may vary, but all tests will be conducted in the morning.

**Students are responsible for marking their answers to each test on the corresponding test answer sheet section; failure to do so will result in wrong test results.**

**Each student is to bring two #2 pencils; mechanical pencils using #2 lead are also permitted.**

**A basic, four-function, scientific, or graphing calculator may be used for the math test only.** USAD® will allow the use of any model graphing calculator — provided it has none of the features listed in Section III (Prohibited Calculators) of the USAD® Calculator Policy on page 40.

**Other papers, word processors, dictionaries, radios, earphones, iPods, watch alarms, coats, hats/hoods, or other miscellaneous items are NOT permitted at the desks or tables during testing. **CELL PHONES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE TESTING ROOMS.****

**AWARDS:** **Certificates** – Every student who tests receives a certificate.

**Ribbons** – 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded to the highest scoring students from each CESA.
