Certification Training (two simultaneous sessions— ELA and Mathematics)

For ELA and Mathematics Content Leaders

Certification Training is designed for content leaders who will be facilitating local work with the Curriculum Companion. The two and a-half days will provide in-depth learning of the content in the curriculum and the capabilities for local implementation. English Language Arts content leaders will learn the K-12 Curriculum Companion in-depth in 2.5 days; and Mathematics content leaders will learn the mathematics Curriculum Companion in-depth in 2.5 days.

The training will be interactive and use online access through laptop computers. The Educator's Guide to the Curriculum Companion will be provided along with other guidance resources.

To attend the training, participants must be representing a "partner" agency with CESA 7. In Wisconsin, the partnership is determined by CESA inter-agency agreements; and nationally, partnership is determined through contractual agreement with CESA 7.
