The Data Retreat® Process, originating at CESA 7 with Dr. Judy K. Sargent, is used throughout the United States, leading districts through data study and school improvement planning.

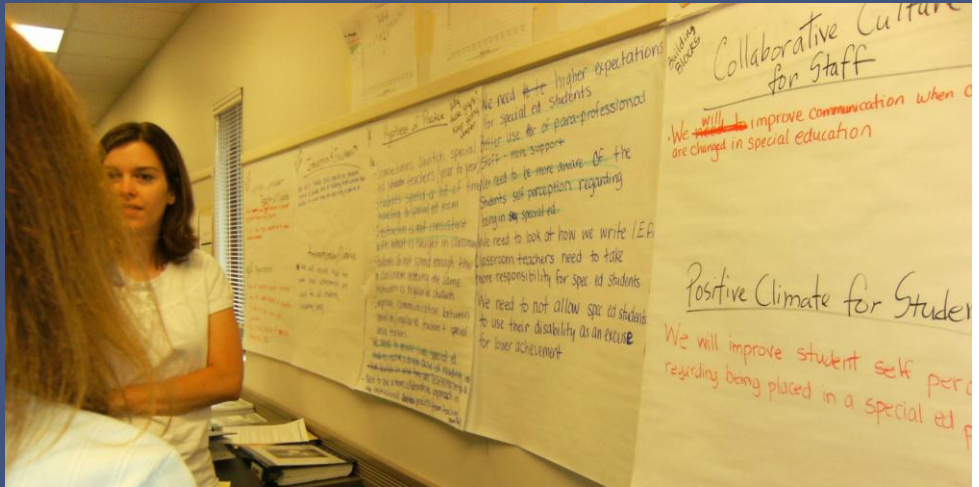
